<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-12 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:			
"(46) Duty to Ensure Academic Freedom. – The State Board of Education shall			
adopt a policy to be implemented by local boards of education to en			
academic freedom in the classroom. Nothing in the policy shall prohibit			
	educator from maintaining a safe and orderly classroom or a timely agenda		
The policy shall include, at a minimum, the following elements:

		political, religious, or nonreligious viewpoints held by all pe	<u>ersons in</u>
		the classroom.	
	<u>b.</u>	Students and educators are permitted to engage in open of	
		critical thinking, and the free exchange of ideas related to the	e content
		of the course.	
	<u>c.</u>	A student shall not be discriminated against or mocked	
		student's ideological, political, religious, or nonreligious view	_
	<u>d.</u>	An educator shall not take a student's ideological, political, r	
		or nonreligious viewpoints into account when evaluating the	student's
		performance.	
	<u>e.</u>	Educators may answer questions posed by students with open	ness and
		honesty."	
Sl	ECTION 2	. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginn	ing with

the 2019-2020 school year.
