9 SECTION 1.1. The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts 10 necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget in 11 accordance with the State Budget Act, Chapter 143C of the General Statutes. Savings shall be 12 effected where the total amounts appropriated are not required to perform these services and 13 accomplish these purposes, and the savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of each 14 fiscal year, except as otherwise provided by G.S. 143C-1-2(b).

SECTION 1.2. This act shall be known as the "Current Operations Appropriations
Act of 2021."
