<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 58-50A-20 reads as rewritten:		
"§ 58-50A-20. Health plan requirements.		
Any group health plan offered by a sponsoring association must meet all of the following		
requirements		
(1	Neither be offered nor advertised to the public generally.	
(2	Provides a level of coverage equal to or greater than sixty percent (609)	%) of
	the actuarial value of allowed costs for covered benefits.	
(3	Provides coverage for hospital and physician services.	
(4	Complies with the provisions of G.S. 58-3-150.

 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2021, and applies to contracts entered into, amended, or renewed on or after that date.
