5	SI	ECTION 1. G.S. 20-141 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:	
6	"(b1) Speed restrictions for State-maintained roads one mile or less in length and located		
7	within a residential subdivision, as that term is defined in G.S. 153A-335, shall be as follows:		
8	<u>(1</u>) No person shall operate a vehicle in excess of 25 miles per hour.	
9	<u>(2</u>) The speed allowed by subdivision (1) of this section may be increased if: (i))
10		two-thirds of the owners of the real property in the subdivision make a request	t
11		to the Department of Transportation by signed petition, and (ii) the	e
12		Department determines on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation	n
13		that a higher maximum speed is reasonable and safe under the conditions	<u>s</u>
14		found to exist.	
15	<u>(3</u>) The speed allowed by subdivision (1) of this section may be decreased if the	e
16		Department determines on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation	<u>1</u>
17		that the speed allowed is greater than is reasonable and safe under the	<u>e</u>
18		conditions found to exist."	
19	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2019, and applies to offenses		
20	committed on or after that date.
