SECTION 1.(d) Notwithstanding any provision of this act or any other provision of			
	law to the contrary, the DSS shall not be required to provide any temporary financial assistance		
	to facilities beyond June 30, 2021, or upon depletion of the State and county funds allocated to		
	the DSS for each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium for this purpose, whichever is earlier.		
SECTION 1.(e) If possible, the DSS shall use an existing mechanism to administer			
	these funds in the least restrictive manner that ensures compliance with this section and timely		
	and accurate payments to facilities. The DSS shall not, under any circumstances, use any portion of the State and county funds allocated to the DSS for each year of the 2010, 2021 fiscal biomnium		
	of the State and county funds allocated to the DSS for each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium for the purpose of this section for any other purpose.		
	SECTION 1.(f) For each year of the 2019-2021 fiscal biennium, the Division of		
	Social Services shall not use more than two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in		
	nonrecurring funds for administrative purposes related to providing financial assistance to		
	Ũ	d to accept State-County Special Assistance, as authorized by this section.	
	SECTION 1.(g) Nothing in this section shall be construed as an obligation by the		
	General Assembly to appropriate funds for the purpose of this section, or as an entitlement by		
	any facility, resident of a facility, or other person to receive temporary financial assistance under		
	this section.
