- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a joint committee on federal nullification; and to provide a directive.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6 <u>Committee on federal nullification - Membership - Duties.</u>

- For purposes of this section, "nullify" means to restrict a state agency or political
 subdivision of the state or an individual employed by a state agency or political
 subdivision of the state from enforcing a federal statute, regulation, or executive order.
- 10 <u>2.</u> During each biennium, the legislative management shall appoint a committee on
- 11 <u>federal nullification in the same manner as the legislative management appoints other</u>
- 12 interim committees. The legislative management shall designate the chairman of the
- 13 <u>committee. The committee shall operate according to the statutes and procedure</u>
- 14 governing the operation of other legislative management interim committees.
- 15 <u>3.</u> <u>The committee shall meet at the call of the chairman of the committee.</u>
- <u>4.</u> Upon receipt of a federal statute, regulation, or executive order, for consideration and process, the committee shall recommend whether to nullify in its entirety a specific
 <u>federal statute, regulation, or executive order.</u>
- 195.The committee may review any existing federal statute, regulation, or executive order20enacted before the effective date of this section and shall recommend whether to
- 21 <u>nullify in its entirety a specific federal statute, regulation, or executive order.</u>
- 22 <u>6.</u> When making a recommendation, the committee shall consider whether the federal
- 23 <u>statute, regulation, or executive order is outside the scope of the powers delegated to</u>
 24 <u>the federal government by the United States Constitution.</u>

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1	<u>7.</u>	Upon the committee's recommendation, the legislative assembly, by concurrent
2		resolution, shall consider whether to nullify the federal action.
3	<u>8.</u>	If the legislative assembly approves the concurrent resolution by a simple majority of
4		the members-elect to nullify a federal statute, regulation, or executive order, the state
5		and the citizens of the state may not be obligated to abide by the federal statute,
6		regulation, or executive order.
7	SEC	CTION 2. DIRECTIVE. The secretary of state shall forward a copy of the enrolled
8	version of this bill to the president of the United States, the president of the United States	
9	Senate, the speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and each member of the	
10	North D	akota congressional delegation.
