- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the veterans' home
- 2 and department of veterans' affairs; to create and enact a new section to chapter 37-15 of the
- 3 North Dakota Century Code, relating to a memorial fund; and to provide for legislative
- 4 management studies.

## 5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 9 other income, to the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of 10 defraying the expenses of the veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs, for the 11 biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013, as follows:

4	2013-15 biennium. The veterans' home and department of veterans' affairs shall report to the				
5	appropriations committees of the sixty-third legislative assembly on the use of this one-time				
6	funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.				
7	SECTION 3. A new section to chapter 37-15 of the North Dakota Century Code is created				
8	and enacted as follows:				
9	Melvin Norgard memorial fund - Creation.				
10	There is created in the state treasury the Melvin Norgard memorial fund. All income related				
11	to a bequest made to the veterans' home by Melvin Norgard, including mineral lease income,				
12	royalties, and sale proceeds, must be transferred or deposited into the Melvin Norgard				
13	memorial fund. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the state treasurer shall invest				
14	moneys in the fund in accordance with section 21-10-07. Investment income of the fund must				
15	be retained in the fund. Moneys in the fund are available, subject to legislative appropriations,				
16	for projects and programs to benefit and serve the residents of the veterans' home. The				
17	legislative assembly shall consider recommendations of the governing board of the veterans'				
18	home when determining appropriations from this fund for projects and programs to benefit and				
19	serve the residents of the veterans' home.				
20	SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEM	MENT STUDY - DISPOSITION OF	THE OLD		
21	VETERANS' HOME FACILITY. During the 2	2011-12 interim, the legislative mar	agement shall		
22	consider studying all available options, inclu	iding demolition, for the disposition	of the old		
23	veterans' home facility. The legislative management shall report its findings and				
24	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to				
25	the sixty-third legislative assembly.				
26	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - DELIVERY OF SERVICES TO				
27	VETERANS. During the 2011-12 interim, th	e legislative management shall cor	sider studying		
28	the delivery of services to veterans, including the consistency in training and of the provision of				
29	services by county veterans' service officers. The legislative management shall report its				
30	findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the				
31	recommendations, to the sixty-third legislati	ve assembly.
