- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact five new sections to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to school district transportation aid payments; and to amend and reenact
- 3 section 15.1-31-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the transportation of open
- 4 enrollment students.

2		transportation aid for all miles [kilometers] traveled and for all students transported,			
3		regardless of whether the students transported live within the incorporated limits of the			
4		city in which the students' school is located.

1	<u>2.</u>	A school district may not receive more than ninety percent of the actual costs incurred
2		for the transportation of students.
3	<u>3.</u>	For purposes of this section, actual costs include the transportation operating
4		expenditures reported to the superintendent of public instruction for the most recent
5		year plus the eight-year average cost of transportation equipment determined by the
6		superintendent of public instruction. Any district having contracted for transportation
7		services may determine the actual costs for the first year the district provides its own
8		transportation services by using the statewide average cost of transportation during
9		the first year.
10	SEC	TION 6. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-31-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
11	amende	d and reenacted as follows:
12	15.1	-31-05. Open enrollment - Transportation.
13	Asc	hool district of residence may provide transportation to a student participating in open
14	enrollme	ent. If a district of residence does not provide transportation to a student participating in
15	open en	rollment, transportation may be provided by the admitting district. A school district may
16	not rece	ive transportation aid disbursements under subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 1 of
17	this Act	or subsection 3 of section 1 of this Act for transporting students who are participating in
18	<u>open en</u>	rollment, or who are enrolled pursuant to a written contract entered by the sending and
19	admitting	g districts which waives the charge and collection of tuition for the student.
