4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

High-demand certificates scholarship.

- The state board of higher education shall adopt policies and procedures to develop,
 implement, promote, and administer a high-demand certificates scholarship program
 to encourage residents of the state to enroll in educational programs for commercial
 driver's license and certified nursing assistant certificates.
 - 2. Individuals enrolled in a qualifying educational program with a physical presence in this state may apply for a scholarship under this section. Eligible applicants must be enrolled in a commercial driver's license or certified nursing assistant program at an accredited institution or other program approved by the board of career and technical education.
 - 3. Subject to legislative appropriations, eligible applicants may be awarded up to five hundred dollars to assist the student with the costs of completing a qualifying certified nursing assistant educational program and up to one thousand five hundred dollars to assist the student with the costs of completing a qualifying commercial driver's license educational program.
 - 4. The state board of higher education shall distribute grants to the accredited institution or other program approved by the board of career and technical education to provide

1	the amounts necessary for the scholarships awarded to the students enrolled in each
2	institution or program.
3	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION - HIGH-
4	DEMAND CERTIFICATES SCHOLARSHIP. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the
5	general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so
6	much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state board of higher education for the purpose of
7	providing financial assistance to students eligible for the high-demand certificates scholarship
8	program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2025.
