

**Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly of North Dakota

HOUSE BILL NO. 1055
(Representatives Zubke, Kempenich, B. Anderson, D. Anderson)
(Senator Bekkedahl)

AN ACT to amend and reenact section 61-16.1-16 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the aggregate total outstanding revenue bond indebtedness limit for water resource districts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 61-16.1-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

61-16.1-16. Revenue bonds.

Each district shall have the power and authority to issue revenue bonds, not exceeding an aggregate total outstanding of ~~ten~~ten million dollars, for the purpose of financing construction of projects and incidental facilities authorized by this chapter. Issuance of revenue bonds must be approved by two-thirds of all of the members of the water resource board. The district shall pledge sufficient revenue from any revenue-producing facility constructed with the aid of revenue bonds for the payment of principal and interest on the bonds and shall establish rates for the facilities at a sufficient level to provide for the operation of such facilities and for the bond payments. Revenue bonds shall not be a general obligation of any county and shall not be secured by property taxes.
