4 SECTION 1.

5 **Display of prisoner of war and missing in action flag - State capitol.**

- 6 The prisoner of war and missing in action flag must be flown daily on the state capitol
- 7 grounds on the middle flagpole on the east side of the heritage center and on a flagpole in front.
- 8 of the all veterans memorial. The prisoner of war and missing in action flag may be displayed on
- 9 its own flagpole or under the flag of the United States.
