1 A BILL for an Act to provide a statement of legislative intent regarding state employee

2 compensation adjustments.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - STATE EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION

5 ADJUSTMENTS - GUIDELINES. It is the intent of the sixty-sixth legislative assembly that

6 2019-21 biennium compensation adjustments for permanent state employees are to be an

7 increase of \$300 per month beginning with the month of July 2019, to be paid in August 2019,

8 and an average increase of one percent beginning with the month of July 2020, to be paid in

9 August 2020. The second year increase is not to be the same percentage increase for each

10 employee, but is to be based on each employee's documented performance.

11 A probationary employee is not entitled to the performance increase. However, the

12 appointing authority may give a probationary employee all or a portion of the increase effective

13 in July, paid in August, or upon completion of probation.

14 The office of management and budget shall develop guidelines for use by state agencies for

15 providing compensation adjustments for regular classified employees. The guidelines must

16 follow section 54-44.3-01.2, compensation philosophy statement.

Employees whose overall documented performance level does not meet standards are noteligible for any salary increase.
