5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 10-30.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Technology award grant program.</u>

- The corporation shall administer a technology award grant program that provides
 matching grants to technology-based businesses.

- 12 (1) Be a North Dakota business that is at the startup stage;
- 13 (2) Be a primary sector business in the technology field; and
- 14 (3) Have a legal structure that was established following comprehensive

 vetting, development of proof of concept, and receipt of intent to fund

 commitment from the corporation.
 - b. Before funds are distributed under this section, the recipient shall provide the corporation with detailed documentation of the availability of two dollars of nonstate angel fund investment matching funds for each dollar of state funds distributed under this section. Matching funds must be cash and may not be in-kind assets.
 - c. An award grant under this section may not exceed fifty thousand dollars. A
 recipient may not receive more than one award under this section.

3	SECTION	2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general
4	fund in the sta	ate treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the
5	sum as may be necessary, to the North Dakota development fund, incorporated, for the purpose	
6	of making tec	hnology award grants as provided for under section 1 of this Act, for the biennium
7	beginning Jul	y 1, 2011, and ending June 30, 2013.
