- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 10-01.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the appointment and affirmation of a registered agent.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 10-01.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 10-01.1-05. Appointment of registered agent.
- 7 1. A registered agent filing must stateprovide:
 - The name <u>and notarized signature</u> of the commercial registered agent of the represented entity; or
- b. If the entity does not have a commercial registered agent, then the name,
 notarized signature, and address of the noncommercial registered agent of the
 entity.
- 13 2. The appointment of a registered agent pursuant to subsection 1 is an affirmation by
 14 the represented entity that the agent has consented to serve as such <u>at the time of</u>
 15 <u>filing and until otherwise notified</u>.
- Upon request and as soon as practicable, the secretary of state shall make available
 in a record a list of filings that contain the name of a registered agent. The list must:
 - a. List in alphabetical order the names of the registered agents; and

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- 20 (1) The type of filing;
- 21 (2) The name of the represented entity making the filing; and
- 22 (3) The address of the principal executive office if disclosed in the record filed by the represented entity.
