- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of adjutant
- 2 general; and to provide exemptions.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state

treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and

other income, to the office of the adjutant general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of

that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

17	SECTION 3. VETERANS' CEMETERY MAINTENANCE FUND - APPROPRIATION. In		

SECTION 3. VETERANS' CEMETERY MAINTENANCE FUND - APPROPRIATION. In addition to the amount appropriated to the adjutant general in the veterans' cemetery line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated any additional funds that are received and deposited in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund pursuant to sections 37-03-14 and 39-04-10.10 for the operation of the North Dakota veterans' cemetery for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

SECTION 4. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS - TRANSFERS. The adjutant general may transfer to the operating expenses and capital assets line items contained in section 1 of this Act up to the sum of \$500,000 from the various other line items contained in section 1 of this Act, as determined necessary by the adjutant general to provide for the maintenance and repair of state-owned armories in this state during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019. Any amounts transferred pursuant to this section must be reported to the director of the office of management and budget.

**SECTION 5. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the radio communications line for the state radio tower package, in section 11 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws are not

- 1 subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds are available for completing these
- 2 projects during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
- 3 **SECTION 6. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the tuition, recruiting, and retention
- 4 line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws is not subject to
- 5 section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used to provide
- 6 tuition assistance, recruiting, and retention incentives to eligible members of the North Dakota
- 7 national guard during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
- 8 **SECTION 7. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the tuition, recruiting, and retention
- 9 line item in section 15 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws is not subject to section
- 10 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used to provide tuition
- 11 assistance to eligible members of the North Dakota national guard, during the biennium
- beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, contingent upon the adjutant general
- 13 certifying to the office of management and budget that the national guard has received a new
- 14 assignment in association with the Grand Forks air force base.
- 15 **SECTION 8. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over pursuant to section 16 of chapter 50
- of the 2015 Session Laws that is unexpended as of June 30, 2017, is not subject to section
- 17 54-44.1-11 and is available for payment of adjusted compensation to veterans. Any unexpended
- 18 funds from this appropriation must be transferred to the veterans' cemetery trust fund during the
- 19 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
- SECTION 9. EXEMPTION. The amount appropriated in the grants line item in subdivision 1
- 21 of section 1 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws for payment of adjusted compensation to
- veterans is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this appropriation
- 23 may be used for payment of adjusted compensation to veterans. Any unexpended funds from
- 24 this appropriation must be transferred to the veterans' cemetery trust fund during the biennium
- beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
- **SECTION 10. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the radio communications line for
- 27 the state radio tower package pursuant to section 17 of chapter 50 of the 2015 Session Laws
- are not subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds are available for completing these
- 29 projects during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
- 30 **SECTION 11. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the disaster costs line for grants
- 31 to political subdivisions for amounts required to match federal dollars on road grade raising

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- 1 projects and federal emergency relief funding pursuant to section 18 of chapter 50 of the 2015
- 2 Session Laws which are unexpended as of June 30, 2017, is not subject to section 54-44.1-11.
- 3 Any unexpended funds from this appropriation are available for these purposes during the
- 4 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.
