- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-10-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to prohibiting entering or driving on a closed road; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-10-21.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 39-10-21.1. Closing road because of hazardous conditions Posting of official
 traffic-control devices Entering or driving on a closed road prohibited.
 - 1. The highway patrol or local law enforcement authorities having jurisdiction over a road may close a road temporarily due to hazardous conditions for the protection and safety of the public. If such a closing is made, the authority ordering the closing shall make every reasonable attempt to notify the public and, when practical, may post appropriate official traffic-control devices to advise motorists of the closing.
 - 2. An individual, while operating a motor vehicle, may not knowingly enter aor drive on a closed road closed whichthat is posted with an appropriate traffic-control device at the point of entry.
