- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-54 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a state artist laureate; to provide a statement of legislative intent; and
- 3 to provide an appropriation.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-54 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

## 7 <u>State artist laureate - Appointment - Duties.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> By August first of each odd-numbered year, the governor shall appoint an individual to
- 9 serve as the state artist laureate for a period of two consecutive years. The individual
- 10 <u>must be a resident of the state and be recognized in the literary, visual arts, cultural,</u>
- 11 education, or academic communities as an artist and have a significant record of high
- 12 <u>quality, published or documented work or service through the arts.</u>
- 13 <u>2.</u> <u>The state artist laureate shall participate in public engagement across the state.</u>
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>Upon completion of a public event, the state artist laureate shall apply for monetary</u>
- 15 reimbursement from the council on the arts for an amount not to exceed one thousand
- 16 dollars for each public engagement event, including travel and material costs. The
- 17 <u>council on the arts may reimburse the state artist laureate up to five thousand dollars</u>
- 18 <u>each year.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the sixty-seventh legislative
- 20 assembly that the creation of the state artist laureate position is to replace the state poet
- 21 laureate as established by the fifty-fourth legislative assembly through Senate Concurrent
- 22 Resolution No. 4039.
- 23 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION COUNCIL ON THE ARTS. There is appropriated out of
- any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of

- 1 \$10,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the council on the arts for the purpose
- 2 of reimbursing the state artist laureate for public engagement events, for the biennium
- 3 beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2023.
