**ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1151**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to the fee for failure to stop at a stop sign and failure to display lighted  
3 headlamps, taillamps, and illuminating devices; and to provide a penalty.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota  
6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except  
8 for:
- 9 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, or 39-10-42, a fee of fifty  
10 dollars.
  - 11 b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or  
12 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
  - 13 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
  - 14 d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02, section 39-08-23, or section  
15 39-08-25, a fee of one hundred dollars.
  - 16 e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one  
17 hundred dollars.
  - 18 f. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a  
19 resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars.
  - 20 g. A violation of subsection 2 of section 39-10-21.1, a fee of two hundred fifty  
21 dollars.
  - 22 h. A violation of section 39-10-59, a fee of five hundred dollars.
  - 23 i. A violation of section 39-09-01, a fee of thirty dollars.
  - 24 j. A violation of section 39-09-01.1, a fee of thirty dollars.

- 1 k. A violation of section 39-10-46 or 39-10-46.1, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- 2 l. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-08-20, one hundred fifty dollars for a first
- 3 violation and three hundred dollars for a second or subsequent violation in three
- 4 years.
- 5 m. A violation of section 39-10-24, 39-10-44, or 39-21-01, a fee of forty dollars.
