4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 49-22-05.1 of the North Dakota

- 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 3. Areas less than one-tenth times the height of the turbine from the property 8 line of a nonparticipating landowner and less than three times the height of the turbine 9 or more from an inhabited rural residence of a nonparticipating landowner, must be 10 excluded in the consideration of a site for a wind energy conversion area, unless a 11 variance is granted. The commission may grant a variance if an authorized 12 representative or agent of the permittee, the nonparticipating landowner, and affected 13 parties with associated wind rights file a written agreement expressing the support of 14 all parties for a variance to reduce the setback requirement in this subsection. A 15 nonparticipating landowner is a landowner that has not signed a wind option or an 16 easement agreement with the permittee of the wind energy conversion facility as 17 defined in chapter 17-04. A local zoning authority may require setback distances 18 greater than those required under this subsection. For purposes of this subsection, 19 "height of the turbine" means the distance from the base of the wind turbine to the 20 turbine blade tip when it is in its highest position. 21 SECTION 2. APPLICATION. This Act applies to projects that receive a certificate of site

compatibility after August 1, 2019.
