4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 44-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- Public employees prohibited from compensation for attending legislative committee

 meetings Exceptions.
- A public employee may not be reimbursed for expenses or be compensated by the public

 entity employing the individual, other than for personal leave taken, for time spent at or traveling

 to or from a session of the legislative assembly or for any legislative standing committee or an

 interim legislative management committee meeting unless:
- 13 <u>1. The public employee has been requested by a member of the legislative assembly to</u>
 14 <u>testify at the meeting; or</u>
- The employee is a state employee who has been requested to attend the meeting by
 the head of the state agency, department, or institution employing the individual to
 provide information on behalf of the agency, department, or institution.
