- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to permits for dredging.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Permit for dredging.
- 7 If a body of water or waterway is designated by the director to require a permit for dredging.
- 8 <u>before a person that for hire engages in dredging that body of water or a waterway, that person</u>
- 9 must obtain a permit from the director. The director shall adopt rules that designate a body of
- water or waterway as requiring a permit for dredging. The designation may include a body of
- water or waterway if it is used or may be used by the public for fishing or recreation and may
- 12 <u>not include a roadway right of way, or a person engaging in dredging on that person's own</u>
- 13 property. The director shall make rules that set the qualifications of a dredger to conduct
- dredging on a designated body of water or waterway. These qualifications must be based on
- 15 <u>having adequate financial responsibility, obtaining the necessary permits, having an adequate</u>
- dredging plan, using the appropriate equipment, and planning for lessening the impact on the
- public use. The director shall create an informational packet on the permitting process and the
- 18 required permits for dredging and shall make this informational packet available on the
- 19 <u>department's website and at the department's offices.</u>
