1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-10 and a new section to

2 chapter 54-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the duty of the state auditor to

3 report consecutive audit findings and the reduction of agency appropriations by the office of

4 management and budget.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:

8 <u>Consecutive audit findings - Report.</u>

9 Within ninety days of the completion of a state agency audit, the state auditor shall notify

10 the legislative audit and fiscal review committee and the director of the budget of any significant

11 <u>audit findings that have been reported in two or more consecutive audits.</u>

SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 54-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:

14 Office of management and budget to reduce appropriations - Audit findings - Report

15 to the legislative audit and fiscal review committee.

- 16 <u>1.</u> <u>Within thirty days of notification from the state auditor that a state agency's audit report</u>
- 17 <u>has contained the same significant audit finding in at least two consecutive audit</u>
- 18 reports, the office of management and budget shall reduce the agency's current
- 19 biennial appropriation, proportionally by line item, as follows:
- 20 <u>a.</u> <u>By one percent if the same finding is identified in three audit reports; or</u>
- 21 b. By two percent if the same finding is identified in four or more audit reports.
- 22 <u>2.</u> <u>The director of the budget shall report any appropriation reductions under this section</u>
- 23 to the legislative audit and fiscal review committee.
