AN ACT to amend and reenact section 20.1-03-27 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to carrying a game and fish license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 20.1-03-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

20.1-03-27. ~~Licenses to be carried on person -- Licenses~~Proof of license to be shown provided officers upon demand - Penalty.

~~Any person holding a hunting, trapping, or fishing license required under this title shall carry the license on that person's person when hunting, trapping, or fishing. Upon the request or demand of the director, the deputy director, any game warden, or any policepeace officer, that person~~ an individual who is hunting, trapping, or fishing immediately shall show the license immediately provide the appropriate license in paper or electronic format to the officer making the request or demand. Any ~~person~~individual who violates this section is guilty of a class 2 noncriminal offense.
