- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study of carbon monoxide alarms.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS.
- 4 During the 2017-18 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the fire code
- 5 and how the existing regulations apply to carbon monoxide alarms, the need for residential
- 6 rental property to be equipped with carbon monoxide alarms, and the costs associated with
- 7 installing carbon monoxide alarms in residential rental property. The study must include the
- 8 types of education and outreach being used by local fire departments to educate communities
- 9 and school children about the dangers of carbon monoxide poisoning. The legislative
- management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation
- 11 required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-sixth legislative assembly.
