1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-01 of the North Dakota 2 Century Code, relating to limitations on requirements to wear a mask at work; to provide an 3 expiration date; and to declare an emergency. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA: 5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 34-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows: 7 Limitations on requirements to wear a mask. 8 If an employer mandates an employee use a face mask, face shield, or other face 9 covering, the employee may opt-out of the requirement by submitting to the employer 10 a certificate: 11 From a licensed physician stating that the physical condition of the employee is 12 such that the face covering would endanger the life or health of the employee; or 13 <u>b.</u> Signed by the employee stating the employee's religious, philosophical, or moral 14 beliefs are opposed to wearing of a face covering. 15 This opt-out provision does not apply to an employee whose employer determines due <u>2.</u> 16 to the nature of the employment setting, the wearing of a face covering is essential. If 17 an employee opts out of the requirement based on a religious belief, the employer 18 shall provide an accommodation as provided under subsection 2 of section 19 14-02.4-03. In determining whether the wearing of a face covering is essential due to 20 the nature of an employment setting, the reason must be a reason that would have
