- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of a teacher reimbursement program; to provide an
- 3 appropriation; and to provide for a transfer.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Teacher reimbursement fund - Program - Administration.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> The superintendent of public instruction shall administer a teacher reimbursement.
 9 program. The superintendent shall adopt rules to administer the program under this
 10 section.
- 112.The teacher reimbursement fund is created in the state treasury for the purpose of12supporting and reimbursing teachers in accordance with the teacher reimbursement
- 13 program.
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>The teacher reimbursement program must:</u>
- 15a.Allow a teacher employed by a school district in the state to submit receipts to the16teacher's employing school district of up to two hundred dollars per school year17for out-of-pocket expenses incurred by the teacher for school supplies and other18necessary items not otherwise provided by the school district.
- 19b.Require the employing school district to reimburse a teacher who submits20receipts for out-of-pocket expenses.
- 21c.Allow the employing school district to submit the receipts to the department of22public instruction for reimbursement from the teacher reimbursement fund.
- 23 <u>d.</u> This section does not apply to out-of-pocket expenses incurred by a teacher for
 24 <u>electronic devices, including computers.</u>

1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - TRANSFER TO TEACHER REIMBURSEMENT FUND -

- 2 **INTENT.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not
- 3 otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary,
- 4 which the office of management and budget shall transfer to the teacher reimbursement fund for
- 5 the purpose of administering a teacher reimbursement program in accordance with section 1 of
- 6 this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.
- 7 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the teacher
- 8 reimbursement fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000, or
- 9 so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of public instruction for the
- 10 purpose of administering the teacher reimbursement program in accordance with section 1 of
- 11 this Act, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021.
