- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15.1-13-23 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to school guidance and counseling services.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-13-23 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 15.1-13-23. School guidance and counseling services Providers.
- 7 Notwithstanding any other law, if an individual possesses a bachelor's degree from an 8 accredited institution in the field of counseling and is enrolled in courses to obtain a 9 graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling program, the 10 board shall issue a provisional two-year license to the individual to provide guidance 11 and counseling services at the elementary and secondary school level. The licensee 12 must obtain a graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling 13 program within two years of the date the provisional license was issued to be eligible 14 for license renewal.
 - 2. Guidance and counseling services at the elementary and secondary school level may be provided by a person holding a graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling program, with coursework and an internship in school counseling, as required for all counselors by the superintendent of public instruction, provided the person has a North Dakota teaching license or will obtain one within seven years from the date of first employment under this section.
 - 3. The board shall conduct a criminal history record check in accordance with section 12-60-24 on each person hired under this section. All costs associated with a background check are the responsibility of the person being hired.

- 4. The board shall monitor a person hired under subsection 1 to ensure the individual
 completes at least one-half of the total credits required for the individual to obtain a
 graduate degree in counseling from a state-approved school counseling program
 within the first calendar year after the date the provisional license is issued.
 - 5. The board shall monitor a person hired under this sectionsubsection 2 to ensure that the person annually completes at least one-seventh of the total credits required for that the person to obtain a teaching license, as determined at the time of employment under this section.
