- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to instruction in personal finance at the middle school level.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Concepts of personal finance Inclusion in curriculum for grades seven and eight
- 7 In addition to the requirements of 15.1-21-01, beginning July 1, 2014, each school district
- 8 <u>shall develop a curriculum for personal finance in consultation with the department of career</u>
- 9 and technical education.
- 10 <u>1. The curriculum must be delivered to students in grades seven or eight.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>The curriculum must include:</u>
- 12 <u>a. Checkbook mechanics, including writing checks, balancing, and statement</u>
- 13 reconciliation;
- b. <u>Saving for larger purchases;</u>
- 15 <u>c. Credit, including credit card usage, interest, and fees:</u>
- 16 <u>d. Earning power, including jobs for teenagers;</u>
- e. Taxation and paycheck withholdings;
- 18 <u>f. Making and living within a budget; and</u>
- 19 <u>g. Consumer rights and responsibilities.</u>
- 20 <u>3. The requirements of this section may be provided by a regular classroom teacher.</u>
