

**HOUSE BILL NO. 1242**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to prohibitions for an individual under twenty-one years of age; and to  
3 provide a penalty.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 5-02-06 of the North Dakota Century  
6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 3. An individual under twenty-one years of age may be permitted to enter and remain in a  
8 restaurant where alcoholic beverages are being sold and in the area of the restaurant  
9 designated for the opening or mixing of alcoholic beverages if the individual is  
10 accompanied by a parent or guardian and the individual does not enter or remain in  
11 the designated area after ten p.m. An individual under twenty-one years of age may  
12 ~~not be permitted to~~ remain in a restaurant where alcoholic beverages are being sold  
13 ~~except~~ if the restaurant is separated from the ~~room~~ designated area in which alcoholic  
14 beverages are opened or mixed and gross sales of food are at least equal to gross  
15 sales of alcoholic beverages which are consumed in the dining area, or if the individual  
16 is employed by the restaurant as a food waiter, food waitress, busboy, or busgirl under  
17 the direct supervision of an individual ~~twenty-one or more~~ twenty-one or more years of age or older and is  
18 not engaged in the sale, dispensing, delivery, or consumption of alcoholic beverages.
