5 **SECTION 1.** A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota

21	<u>(3)</u>	"Taxpayer" means the parent or legal guardian of a qualifying child.	
22	2 SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after
