- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 20.1-08-04.5 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to the use of scopes on muzzleloading firearms for individuals over sixty-five
- 3 years of age.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 20.1-08-04.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 20.1-08-04.5. Governor's proclamation concerning the hunting of deer with
- 8 muzzleloading firearms.
- The governor shall by proclamation provide for a muzzleloading firearm season following
- 10 the regular deer hunting season to hunt deer with muzzleloading firearms in the manner,
- 11 number, places, and times as the governor prescribes. Licenses to hunt deer with
- muzzleloading firearms must be issued by the director by lottery as prescribed by the director.
- 13 The director shall issue two percent of the total white-tailed deer gun licenses available each
- 14 year to hunters with muzzleloading firearms. Of the two percent, one-half of the licenses issued
- may be for antlered white-tailed deer. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an individual
- over sixty-five years of age who receives a license to hunt deer with a muzzleloading firearm
- 17 and is in lawful possession of a muzzleloading firearm may use a telescopic sight not to exceed
- 18 <u>four-power magnification on the muzzleloading firearm when hunting deer.</u>
