- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact sections 15-04-25, 15-04-25.1, and 15-04-25.2 of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to the state land advisory board.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 15-04-25 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as

5 follows:

6	<u>15-(</u>	)4- <u>25</u>	. State land advisory board - Appointment - Qualifications - Term.
7	<u>1.</u>	<u>The</u>	state land advisory board consists of eight members, one from each of the
8		follc	wing districts, appointed by the governor:
9		<u>a.</u>	District one consists of Divide, McKenzie, and Williams Counties.
10		<u>b.</u>	District two consists of Bottineau, Burke, McHenry, Mountrail, Pierce, Renville,
11			and Ward Counties.
12		<u>C.</u>	District three consists of Benson, Cavalier, Eddy, Ramsey, Rolette, and Towner
13			Counties.
14		<u>d.</u>	District four consists of Grand Forks, Nelson, Pembina, and Walsh Counties.
15		<u>e.</u>	District five consists of Cass, Ransom, Richland, Sargent, Steele, and Traill
16			Counties.
17		<u>f.</u>	District six consists of Barnes, Dickey, Foster, Griggs, LaMoure, Logan, McIntosh,
18			Stutsman, and Wells Counties.
19		<u>g.</u>	District seven consists of Burleigh, Emmons, Grant, Kidder, McLean, Mercer,
20			Morton, Oliver, Sheridan, and Sioux Counties.
21		<u>h.</u>	District eight consists of Adams, Billings, Bowman, Dunn, Golden Valley,
22			Hettinger, Slope, and Stark Counties.

1	<u>2.</u>	All members must be bona fide farmers or ranchers. Each appointment must be made		
2		from a list of three names submitted by agricultural organizations requested by the		
3		governor to submit the list.		
4	<u>3.</u>	Appointments are for a term of four years from July first of the year of appointment,		
5		and continue until a successor has been appointed and qualified. Vacancies occurring		
6		other than by the expiration of an appointive term may be filled by appointment for the		
7		remainder of the term. No member of the board may serve longer than two full terms.		
8		The members of the advisory board are subject to removal by the governor for cause		
9		<u>only.</u>		
10	<u>4.</u>	The advisory board shall select from its members a chairman, vice chairman, and		
11		secretary who serve in these positions until June thirtieth of the year next following		
12		their selection.		
13	SEC	SECTION 2. Section 15-04-25.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted		
14	as follows:			
15	<u>15-04-25.1. Compensation.</u>			
16	Each member of the advisory board is entitled to be paid a per diem of sixty-two dollars and			
17	fifty cents for each day of service, including time of travel between home and the meeting			
18	location, for each meeting required by section 15-04-25.2 held in that member's respective			
19	district and for meetings of the advisory board. Each member is entitled to be reimbursed for			
20	necessary and actual expenses at the rates and in the manner provided by law for other state			
21	officers. The compensation and expenses must be paid out of the board of university and			
22	school lands' appropriations.			
23	SECTION 3. Section 15-04-25.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted			
24	as follows:			
25	15-04-25.2. Meetings and duties.			
26	<u>1.</u>	Each board member shall hold a public meeting at least twice each fiscal year in the		
27		board member's district to make presentations and determine the needs and opinions		
28		of those interested in leasing state land.		
29	<u>2.</u>	The board shall meet at least once each fiscal year.		
30	<u>3.</u>	The board may advise the commissioner of university and school lands regarding any		
31		policy relating to the lease of state land and may make general recommendations

- 2 <u>recommendations to the governor.</u>
