- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 52-04-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to unemployment benefits chargeable against a nonprofit organization as a base period
- 3 employer.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 52-04-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 **52-04-07**. Benefits paid chargeable to accounts of base-period employers.
- Benefits paid to an individual must be charged against the accounts of the individual's
 base-period employers. The amount of benefits so chargeable against each
- 10 base-period employer's account must bear the same ratio to the benefits paid to an
- 11 individual as the base-period wages paid to the individual by such employer bear to
- the total amount of the base-period wages paid to the individual by all of theindividual's base-period employers.
- 14 2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, an employer's account may not be charged for any of15 the following:
- 16a.With benefits paid to an individual for unemployment that is directly caused by a17major natural disaster declared by the president pursuant to section 102(2) of the18Disaster Relief Act of 1974 [Pub. L. 93-288; 88 Stat. 143; 42 U.S.C. 5122(2)], if
- 19 the individual would have been eligible for disaster unemployment assistance
- with respect to that unemployment but for the individual's receipt ofunemployment insurance benefits.
