- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 12-44.1 and section 12-60-16.12
- 2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the confidentiality of booking photos and the
- 3 unauthorized dissemination of criminal history record information; to amend and reenact
- 4 subsection 2 of section 44-04-18.7 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to criminal
- 5 information; and to provide a penalty.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 7 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 12-44.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 8 and enacted as follows:
- 9 **Prohibition Booking photo Confidential.**
- <u>Unless there is a public safety or law enforcement interest warranting release, the</u>
  booking photo of an arrestee is a confidential record until the arrestee:
- 12 <u>a.</u> Fails to appear for court;
- 13 <u>b.</u> <u>Is a fugitive from justice; or</u>
- 14 <u>c.</u> <u>Is charged with the offense for which the arrestee was arrested or an offense</u>
  15 <u>related to the offense for which the arrestee was arrested.</u>
- 16 2. <u>This section does not prohibit the dissemination of booking photos among or on behalf</u>
  17 <u>of law enforcement agencies or officers.</u>
- 18 <u>3.</u> <u>An individual who violates this section is not subject to a penalty under section</u>
- 19 <u>12.1-13-01.</u>
- 20 **SECTION 2.** Section 12-60-16.12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted
- 21 as follows:
- 22 <u>12-60-16.12. Criminal history record information Civil action Penalty.</u>
- 23 <u>A person that disseminates, publishes, or maintains or causes to be disseminated,</u>
- 24 published, or maintained, the criminal history record information of an individual which pertains

1	to that individual's charge or arrest for a criminal offense, and solicits, requests, or accepts		
2	money or other thing of value for removing the criminal history record information is civilly liable.		
3	to that individual in the amount of five hundred dollars or actual damages, whichever is greater,		
4	plus reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.		
5	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 44-04-18.7 of the North Dakota		
6	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:		
7	2.	"Crir	minal intelligence and investigative information" does not include:
8		a.	Arrestee description, including name, date of birth, address, race, sex, physical
9			description, and occupation of arrestee.
10		b.	Facts concerning the arrest, including the cause of arrest and the name of the
11			arresting officer.
12		C.	Conviction information, including the name of any person convicted of a criminal
13			offense.
14		d.	Disposition of all warrants, including orders signed by a judge of any court
15			commanding a law enforcement officer to arrest a particular person.
16		e.	A chronological list of incidents, including initial offense report information
17			showing the offense, date, time, general location, officer, and a brief summary of
18			what occurred.
19		f.	A crime summary, including a departmental summary of crimes reported and
20			public calls for service by classification, nature, and number.
21		g.	Radio log, including a chronological listing of the calls dispatched.
22		h.	General registers, including jail booking information.
23		<del>i.</del>	Arrestee photograph, if release will not adversely affect a criminal investigation.
