- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision i of subsection 1 of section 39-09-02 and
- 2 section 39-09-09 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to speed limitations on multilane
- 3 highways and minimum speed limits; and to provide a penalty.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subdivision i of subsection 1 of section 39-09-02 of the North
 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - Seventy-fiveEighty miles [120.70128.75 kilometers] an hour on access-controlled, paved and divided, multilane interstate highways, unless otherwise permitted, restricted, or required by conditions.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-09-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

39-09-09. Minimum speed limits.

- An individual may not drive a motor vehicle at a reduced speed so as to impede the normal and reasonable movement of traffic except when reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.
- 2. If Subject to subsection 3, if the director and the superintendent of the highway patrol, acting jointly, or a local authority within the authority's jurisdiction, determines on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that slow speeds on any highway or part of a highway impede the safe, normal, and reasonable movement of traffic, the director and superintendent or the local authority may determine and declare a minimum speed limit below which an individual may not drive a vehicle except when necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law, and that limit is effective when posted upon appropriate fixed or variable signs.

- 1 3. Except as otherwise authorized by law, an individual may not drive a motor vehicle at
- 2 <u>a speed of less than forty miles [64.37 kilometers] an hour while on an</u>
- 3 <u>access-controlled, paved and divided, multilane interstate highway. This section does</u>
- 4 not apply to department of transportation highway operations.
