10		vehicle, except that sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction, or and
11		water or other substance may be sprinkled on a roadway in cleaning or maintaining
12		the roadway.
13	<u>2.</u>	No personAn individual may not operate on any highway any vehicle with any load
14		unless the load and any covering thereonon the vehicle is securely fastened so as to
15		prevent saidthe covering or load from becoming loose, detached, or in any manner a
16		hazard to other users of the highway.
17	<u>3.</u>	An individual may not operate a vehicle with a registered gross weight that exceeds
18		twenty thousand pounds [9071.84 kilograms] on any highway if the vehicle is used to
19		haul a load of soil, sand, rocks, rock chips, or gravel without a secure cover that keeps
20		the load within or on the vehicle, unless the vehicle is owned or operated by the state
21		or a political subdivision.
