1 A BILL for an Act to prohibit bisphenol-A in products for young children; and to provide a penalty.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

3 SECTION 1.

4 **Prohibition of bisphenol-A in young children's products - Penalty.**

5 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section:</u>

6		a. <u>"Child" means an individual under three years of age.</u>
7		b. "Children's product" means an empty bottle or cup to be filled with food or liquid
8		which is designed or intended by a manufacturer to be used by a child. The term
9		does not include used products.
10	<u>2.</u>	After December 31, 2011, a manufacturer or wholesaler may not sell or offer for sale in
11		this state a children's product that contains bisphenol-A. After December 31, 2012, a
12		retailer may not sell or offer for sale in this state a children's product that contains
13		bisphenol-A. Violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor.
