4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 34-06-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is

13		C.	Effective <del>July 24, 2009August 1, 2023</del> , a wage of at least seveneleven dollars
14			and twenty-five cents per hour;
15		<u>d.</u>	Effective August 1, 2024, a wage of at least twelve dollars per hour;
16		<u>e.</u>	Effective August 1, 2025, a wage of at least thirteen dollars per hour;
17		<u>f.</u>	Effective August 1, 2026, a wage of at least fourteen dollars per hour; and
18		<u>g.</u>	Effective August 1, 2027, a wage of at least fifteen dollars per hour.
19	2.	This	section does not limit the authority of the commissioner to adopt rules
20		esta	blishing aexceptions to the state minimum wage rate that differswhich differ from
21		the	rates established under subsection 1.
