## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 32-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 <u>Employer immunity for COVID-19 Exceptions.</u>
- 8 1. As used in this section:
  - a. "COVID-19" means:
- 10 (1) Severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 identified as
- 11 SARS-CoV-2; and
- 12 (2) Any disease caused by severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2

  13 identified as SARS-CoV-2.
- b. "Employee" means an individual who performs a service for wages or other
   remuneration under a contract of hire, written or oral, express or implied. The
- 16 term includes an independent contractor.
- 17 <u>c. "Employer" means the person that employs the employee.</u>
- 18 <u>2. Subject to subsection 3, an employer is immune from civil liability for damage, loss, or</u>
- 19 <u>injury that results from an employee contracting, being exposed to, or potentially being</u>
- 20 <u>exposed to COVID-19 during the course of employment.</u>
- 21 <u>3. Immunity under subsection 2 does not apply to damage, loss, or injury caused by an</u>
- 22 <u>an employer's willful misconduct or infliction of harm.</u>

- 1 **SECTION 2. APPLICATION.** This Act applies to all civil actions filed after March 1, 2021.
- 2 This Act applies to claims by an employee or former employee who knew or reasonably should
- 3 have known about the contraction, exposure, or potential exposure to COVID-19 before the
- 4 effective date of this Act.
