1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 15.1-07-14 of the North Dakota Century Code,  
2 relating to qualified electors for purposes of school district bond elections.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 15.1-07-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **15.1-07-14. Qualified elector.**

7 1. An individual who is a qualified elector of this state may:

8 a. Vote to elect board members for the school district in which the individual resides.

9 b. Serve as a board member for the school district in which the individual resides.

10 c. Serve as a judge or clerk of election for the school district in which the individual  
11 resides.

12 d. Serve as the business manager of a school district.

13 2. For the purposes of elections held under this chapter, an individual residing on a  
14 military installation is deemed to be a resident of a school district if the school district  
15 admits students from the military installation pursuant to a contract and receives  
16 impact aid pursuant to Public Law No. 81-874 [64 Stat. 1100; 20 U.S.C. 236 et seq.],  
17 as amended.

18 3. For the purposes of an election on the question of approving bonds of a school district  
19 under chapter 21-03, a qualified elector includes any citizen of the United States who  
20 has attained the age of eighteen years and is a freeholder within the school district.
