- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the attendance of mature students at institutions of higher education.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Mature students Attendance at institutions of higher education.
- 7 <u>1. Any resident of this state who is at least fifty-five years of age may attend any </u>
- 8 <u>undergraduate course or class offered by an institution of higher education under the</u>
- 9 <u>control of the state board of higher education without a charge of tuition or fees, and</u>
- without having to demonstrate the achievement of certain academic thresholds
- 11 normally required of students.
- 12 <u>2. Notwithstanding subsection 1, any student duly admitted to the institution must be</u>
- given priority with respect to enrollment in courses or classes having a maximum
- 14 <u>allowable enrollment.</u>
- 15 <u>3. An institution may not employ additional staff or increase the availability of courses or</u>
- classes based solely on interest expressed by students referenced in subsection 1.
- 17 4. If a student referenced in subsection 1 successfully completes the requirements of any
- 18 course or class attended in accordance with this section, the student shall be awarded
- 19 <u>academic credit by the institution.</u>
- 20 <u>5.</u> All books, supplies, and expenses other than tuition and fees are the responsibility of
- 21 the student.
- 22 6. Each institution shall account for the students referenced in subsection 1 as a
- separate class of attendees and may not include them in any other student counts for
- 24 <u>any other purposes.</u>
