- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 28-32-14 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the attorney general review of proposed administrative rules.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 28-32-14 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **28-32-14. Attorney general review of rules.**

- 7 <u>1.</u> Every rule proposed by any administrative agency must be submitted to the attorney
- 8 general for an opinion as to its the rule's legality before final adoption, and the attorney
- 9 general promptly shall furnish each such<u>that</u> opinion.
- 10 <u>2.</u> The attorney general may not approve any rule as to legality when the<u>if:</u>
- 11 <u>a.</u> <u>The</u> rule exceeds the statutory authority of the agency or;
- 12 <u>b.</u> <u>The rule</u> is written in a manner that is not concise or easily understandable;
- 13 <u>c.</u> <u>The rule is contrary to legislative intent;</u> or when the
- 14d.The procedural requirements for adoption of the rule in this chapter are not15substantially met.
- <u>For purposes of subdivision c of subsection 2, contrary to legislative intent includes the</u>
 proposal of a rule by an administrative agency within a period of four years after the
- 18 legislative assembly has failed to pass a bill that is substantially similar, in whole or in
- 19 part, to the proposed rule.
- 20 <u>4.</u> The attorney general shall advise an agency of any revision or rewording of a rule
 21 necessary to correct objections as to legality.
