- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-03 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the introduction of bills by executive branch agencies and the judicial
- 3 branch.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7	Introduction of bills b	y executive branch agencies and the judicial I	branch.

- 8 <u>1.</u> Except as otherwise provided in this section and sections 54-44.1-06, 54-44.1-06.1,
   9 and 54-44.1-07, executive branch agencies and the judicial branch may not submit
- 10 legislative bills for introduction to the legislative assembly.
- <u>The judicial branch shall submit a bill including the budget request of the judicial</u>
   <u>branch to the legislative council within seven days after adjournment of each</u>
   <u>organizational session.</u>
- 14 <u>3.</u> <u>An executive branch agency or the judicial branch may submit a legislative bill for</u>
- 15 introduction if requested by a legislative management committee or if requested or
- 16 <u>authorized by a standing committee of the legislative assembly. Any bill introduced</u>
- 17 <u>under this subsection must be deemed to be introduced by the legislative</u>
- 18 <u>management or the standing committee that requested or authorized the introduction</u>
   19 <u>of the bill.</u>
- 20 <u>4.</u> An executive branch agency or the judicial branch may request a member of the
- 21 legislative assembly to introduce a bill on behalf of the agency or the judicial branch. A
- 22 <u>bill introduced under this subsection by a member of the legislative assembly also</u>
- 23 <u>must specify the name of the requesting entity.</u>
