- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 54-03-02 and 54-35-16 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to annually reconvened sessions of the legislative assembly; and to
- 3 provide for a legislative management study.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-03-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 54-03-02. When legislative assembly meets.
 - The legislative assembly shall meet at the seat of government in the month of
 December following the election of theits members thereof for organizational and
 orientation purposes and shall thereafter recess after the organizational session until
 the time provided in subsection 2.
 - 2. The legislative assembly shall reconvene at twelve noon on the first Tuesday after the third day in January of the year following the organizational session as provided in subsection 1 or at twelve noon on a date selected by the legislative management but not earlier than January second nor later than January eleventh of the year following the organizational session and, following. Following the close of business of the regular session, shall adjourn subject to subsection 3, but reserving at least five of the natural days available under the constitution for the legislative session, the legislative assembly shall recess subject to subsections 3 and 4.
 - 3. The legislative assembly shall reconvene at twelve noon on a date selected by the legislative management which is not earlier than February fifteenth nor later than March first of the second year after the organizational session. After reconvening, the legislative assembly shall use no less than three natural days available under the constitution for the legislative session to address matters related to the state budget

- and appropriations. Following the close of business or the end of the natural days

 available under the constitution for the legislative session, whichever occurs first, the

 legislative assembly shall adjourn subject to subsection 4.
 - 4. Notwithstanding a motion to recess or adjourn sine die, the legislative assembly shall reconvene as determined by the legislative management. The number of natural days used may not exceed the number of natural days available under the constitution which have not been previously used by that legislative assembly in regular session, and, if the legislative assembly has not yet reconvened under subsection 23, at least five of the natural days available under the constitution must be reserved to fulfill that subsection.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-35-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

54-35-16. Authority to determine if legislative assembly meets.

The legislative management may issue a call for the legislative assembly to convene after it has adjourned under subsection 2 or 3 of section 54-03-02. The length of a legislative session called under this section may not exceed the number of natural days available under the constitution which have not been used by that legislative assembly, and, if the legislative assembly has not yet reconvened under subsection 3 of section 54-03-02, at least five of the natural days must be reserved to fulfill that subsection. The legislative management may exercise this authority, and the legislative assembly shall meet, regardless of whether the motion to close the regular session of the legislative assembly was to recess to a time certain, adjourn to a time certain, or adjourn sine die.

SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - ANNUAL LEGISLATIVE
SESSIONS. During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying annually reconvening the regular session of the legislative assembly with a more equal distribution of the eighty natural days available for the session between odd-numbered years and even-numbered years. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative assembly.
