- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to public notice of wildlife surveys and studies; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 20.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Aerial surveys and ground studies Public notice Damages.
- At least thirty days before undertaking a wildlife survey or study in the air or on the ground,
- 8 <u>a person that lacks an ownership interest in, or other license or privilege to enter, property</u>
- 9 reasonably expected to be affected by the survey or study shall provide public notice of the
- 10 survey or study in the official county newspapers in the area reasonably expected to be affected
- by the survey or study, and, if any, on the person's website and social media accounts. The
- 12 <u>notice must provide the date, time, location, and manner of the survey or study. A person whose</u>
- property is damaged as a result of a wildlife survey or study is entitled to damages.
