- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to eligibility for gratis
- 2 licenses to hunt elk or moose.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 4 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - GRATIS LICENSES TO HUNT ELK

- 5 **OR MOOSE.** During the 2019-20 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying
- 6 eligibility for gratis licenses authorizing residents to hunt elk or moose. The study must consider:
- 7 1. Which persons should be eligible for gratis licenses to hunt elk or moose;
- 8 2. How often an eligible person should be allowed to apply for a license;
- 9 3. When an eligible person should be able to transfer the person's eligibility:
- What the impact of a transfer of eligibility should be on a person's future eligibility for a license and for a raffle under section 20.1-08-04.2 or section 20.1-08-04.6;
- When an eligible individual's spouse, children, and parents should be eligible for a
  license or allowed to hunt elk or moose with the eligible individual; and
- 14 6. Other issues the legislative management deems relevant.
- 15 The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any
- 16 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-seventh legislative
- 17 assembly.
