- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 54-01-29 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to negotiation for the transfer of excess lands around Lake Sakakawea and Lake Oahe.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** Section 54-01-29 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>54-01-29. Negotiation for the transfer of excess lands Generally.</u>
- The state board of university and school lands shall negotiate with the United States
 army corps of engineers for the return of excess lands around Lake Sakakawea above
 elevation 1,854 feet mean sea level and excess lands around Lake Oahe above 1,617
 feet mean sea level to the state for transfer to the appropriate persons.
 - 2. If the United States army corps of engineers transfers land surrounding Lake Sakakawea or Lake Oahe to the state government, the ownership of land located within a Native American reservation is to be determined by the tribe and the ownership of land not located within a reservation is to be determined by the appropriate county. The state board of university and school lands shall accept
