6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:					
7	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 8 of section 16.1-08.1-01 of the North Dakota					
8	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
