- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 53-06.1-08 and 53-06.1-08.2 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to pull tabs and electronic pull tab devices.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 53-06.1-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 5 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 53-06.1-08. Punchboards and pull tabs.
- 7 Unless all top tier winning pull tabs or punchboard punches of a game have been
- 8 redeemed, or unless otherwise permitted by a gaming rule or the attorney general, a person or
- 9 organization may not close the game after it has been placed in play. The maximum sales price
- 10 per pull tab and punchboard punch is two dollars. The maximum prize value of a top tier winning
- pull tab or punchboard punch is five hundred dollars. The With the exception of electronic pull
- 12 <u>tabs, the game of pull tabs may only be conducted by commingling deals.</u>
- 13 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 53-06.1-08.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 14 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **53-06.1-08.2.** Electronic pull tab device requirements.
- An electronic pull tab device must display an electronic pull tab in which the player may win
- 17 credits that can be redeemed for cash or used to purchase more pull tabs. A device with a
- 18 <u>currency validator must accept United States paper currency or a credit ticket voucher through</u>
- 19 the device's currency validator. The device may not directly dispense coins, cash, tokens, or
- anything else of value other than a credit ticket voucher.
