STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 5 This measure would require at least one member of each legislative district to be elected each
- 6 biennial election.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE

8 **SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

- 9 That the following proposed amendment to section 3 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 10 North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the
- 11 general election to be held in 2012, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
- 12 Constitution of North Dakota.
- 13 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 3 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota is
- 14 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 Section 3. The legislative assembly shall establish by law a procedure whereby one-half of
- 16 the members of the senate and one-half of the members of the house of representatives, as
- 17 nearly as is practicable, are elected biennially <u>and at least one member of each legislative</u>
- 18 district is elected biennially.
